- Staffing updates: Mr. Walker on military leave; full-time sub coming in. Other two teachers zooming or physically moving as needed. Ms. Gorman helping as well during sixth block. Mr. Devero has left, have a candidate and waiting for a confirmation.
- Gained a campus security associate
- Looking to increase test scores. Round 2 of MAP tests was this week. Will have school and student-level data. Will re-shuffle 6th-block assignments based on results. Ms. Gorman sent comms about extended day beginning February 27 for kids who did not perform well on MAPs or EOG or teacher observations.
- Panorama survey; students can opt out. But data helps determine what needs to be focused on during SLT time. Student engagement showed as a need.
- Lottery is wrapping up
- Registration comes up next
- Binders are setting off security scanners, but trying to find plastic-ringed binders as a replacement
- Wraps for bathroom stalls that prevent graffiti
- Magnet boundary changes have been a big deal. None specific to Piedmont, but seeing that some of the changes happening elsewhere could have an impact on Piedmont (Irwin, Sedegefield and others). Might need help getting a Board of Education member involved.
- Ms. Thornburg shared that we won Magnet Schools of America's School of Excellence Award. She also discussed:
