Elected Officers Roles for Next Year Title and Responsibilities:

President: Serve as leader and key contact for the PTSA; preside at all PTSA meetings; ex-officio member of most committees; appoint chairpersons for special committees; coordinate the work of the officers and committees so that the PTSA's objectives can be met. (Effort: year-round, on-going)

Vice President(2): Act as an aide to the President; perform the duties of the President in the absence or inability of the officer to serve; assume other responsibilities as assigned by the Executive Board; coordinate the general activities of any Special Committees created by the Executive Board. (Effort: year-round, time varies depending upon roles)

Secretary: Keep the minutes of all general meetings and all meetings of the Executive Board; prepare correspondence and perform all other duties assigned; maintain master documents; keep the calendar of events for the PTSA; attending PTSA meetings; type up and distribute the meeting minutes; and update and distribute the weekly newsletter. (Effort: 3 - 4 hours per month)

Treasurer: Be responsible for and have custody of all funds; make disbursements as properly authorized; answer questions regarding available funds; assure that PTSA policies and best practices are followed with regards to funds; prepare the books for all audit activities; and prepare financial reports for each meeting. (Effort: 10-12 hours per month, depending on activities)
